

HSCF PHOTOGRAPHY AWARDS ENTRY RULES

RULES

- All applicants must have been HSCF members when submitted photograph was taken.
- The photographer must enter the photograph, not the individual captured in the photograph. If selected as a winner in the contest, the award will be credited to the photographer and not the subject.
- The photo entered must have been taken between December 14th, 2017 and December 15th, 2018.
- Any photographs that have been previously entered into any HSCF awards competition may not be re-entered.
- All photographs must be originals.
- All entries must be completed and received in the HSCF office by December 15.
- No member judging the competition may have an entry in the category they are judging.
- Digital Photographs: (preferred)
 - One photograph entry per submission.
 - Save image as: Category, first name, last name and # of entry.
 - Photograph should be 1 MB or larger, 300 dpi preferred.
- Printed Photographs:
 - Each photograph must be marked on the back of the photo with the category, first name, last name and the number of entry. Do not use pen that will bleed through the photograph.
- Winners
 - Awards: The winners of each category will receive an award honoring their photographic achievement at the Friday night convention banquet.
 - Winning photographs will be published in Hunter's Horn magazine and other HSCF media.
- Judging Criteria:
 - Composition
 - Originality
 - Creativity
 - Quality of photograph, not quality of the trophy
- One person may not win more than one (1) category each year, with the exception of an individual category and Best in Show.
