



Houston Safari Club Foundation Event Protocols

In a year of unique circumstances, Houston Safari Club Foundation is required to recommend protocols for events and gatherings, in relation to Coronavirus (COVID-19). These protocols are intended to allow participants to gather in a safe manner, with a focus on attendee health, safety, and well-being.

1. Please do not plan to attend an HSCF event under the following conditions:
 - a. Symptoms If you are experiencing any known COVID-19 symptoms include but are not limited to headache, cough, fever, sore throat, or runny nose.
 - b. If you have been exposed to someone that has received a positive diagnosis of Coronavirus (COVID-19) within the last fourteen (14) days or has exhibited symptoms of Coronavirus (COVID-19).
2. Wash your hands frequently with soap and water. Avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth.
3. Limit handshaking and normal greeting to elbow bumping, nodding or some other non-physical contact.
4. Cover your coughs or cough into your sleeve. Use clean tissues to open and close doors, operate faucets, toilets, and soap dispensers. Dispose of the tissue immediately.
5. Face covering requirements:
 - a. Under the State of Texas-mandated face covering requirement, every person in Texas shall wear a face covering over the nose and mouth when inside a commercial entity or other building or space open to the public, or when in an outdoor public space, wherever it is not feasible to maintain six feet of social distancing from another person not in the same household; for further details and exemptions, see: <https://gov.texas.gov/uploads/files/press/EO-GA-29-use-of-face-coverings-during-COVID-19-IMAGE-07-02-2020.pdf>
 - b. Face coverings are recommended when in an area or performing an activity which will necessarily involve close contact or proximity to others.
 - c. Requirements may vary by city or county. Please check your city or county's website to find out if there is a requirement in place.
 - d. Should face masks be required or desired, please bring a personal face mask to all HSCF events.
