



## BYRON G. SADLER BOWHUNTING AWARD

### PURPOSE

The purpose of this award is to recognize outstanding achievements in bowhunting.

### ELIGIBILITY

- The applicant must have taken a minimum of forty-five (45) species across five (5) continents.
- The applicant must be an active member of Houston Safari Club Foundation, in good standing.
- The applicant must be of good character and have a known ethical hunting standard.

### SELECTION CRITERIA

- Applicants will be judged on the following categories:
  - Hunting accomplishments: number of hunts, quality of species; difficulty of hunts.
  - Support of and involvement with HSCF including, but not limited to, membership history, support of HSCF and HSCF programs and active involvement in HSCF activities in support of HSCF's mission statement.
  - A history of actions in support of the advancement of hunting, conservation and education.

### ENTRY

- Prospective recipients must submit their application by November 1st of the year prior to the HSCF Worldwide Hunting Expo & Convention.
- SCI records and/or photo evidence of each animal must be provided.

### HUNTING REQUIREMENTS (with a Bow)

- A minimum of forty-five (45) species across five (5) continents, as listed:
  - Africa 15 species (must include 2 of the dangerous game of Africa)
  - North America: 10 species (free range; must include 2 bear, 2 sheep, 1 moose, 1 elk, 1 caribou)
  - South America: 4 species
  - South Pacific: 4 species
  - Europe: 2 species
  - Asia: 2 species
  - Mountain Species (free range)
    - 2 Mountain Goats
    - 2 Mountain Sheep
  - Predators of the World: 4 species
