



FEMALE OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENT IN HUNTING AWARD

PURPOSE

The purpose of this award is to recognize outstanding achievements in big game hunting, by a female hunter.

ELIGIBILITY

- The applicant must have taken at least 50 species across 4 continents.
- The applicant must be 19 years of age or older.
- The applicant must be a voting, active member of Houston Safari Club Foundation, in good standing.
- The applicant must be of good character and have a known ethical hunting standard.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Applicants will be judged on the following categories:
 - Hunting accomplishments: number of hunts, quality of species; difficulty of hunts.
 - Support of and involvement with HSCF including, but not limited to, membership history, support of HSCF and HSCF programs and active involvement in HSCF activities in support of HSCF's mission statement.
 - A history of actions in support of the advancement of hunting, conservation and education.

ENTRY

- Prospective recipients must submit their application by November 1st of the year prior to the HSCF Worldwide Hunting Expo & Convention.
- SCI Records and/or photo evidence of each animal must be provided.
